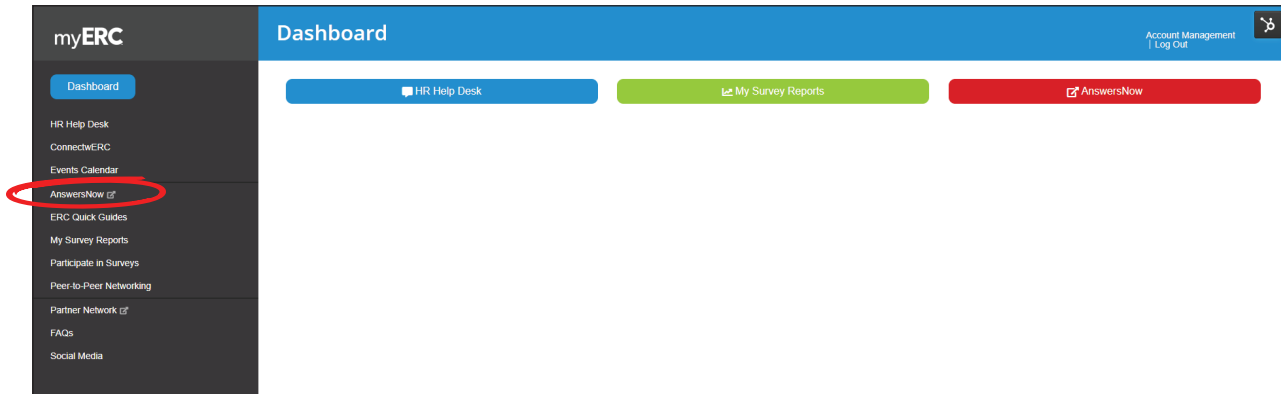


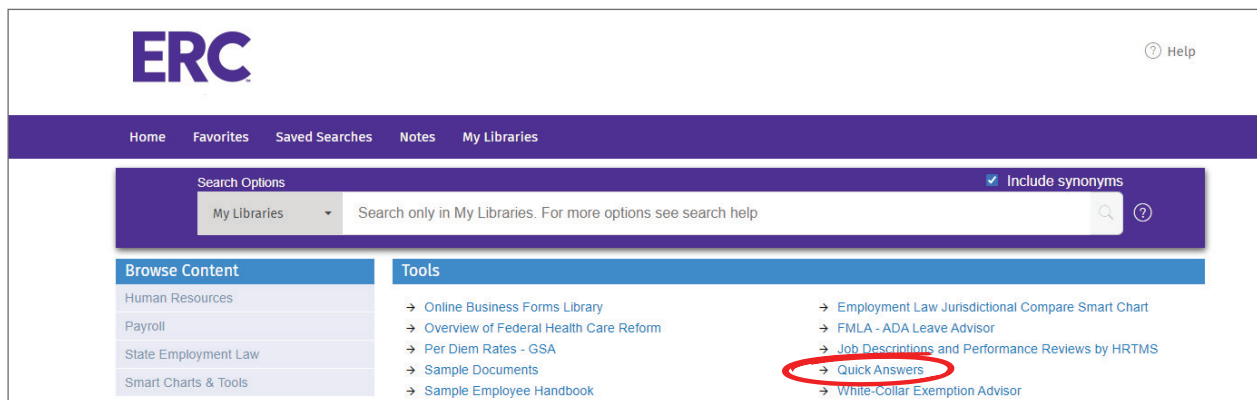
How to Access Federal and State Labor Law Posters in myERC

To access printable federal and state labor law posters, log into the myERC member resource portal by visiting <https://www.yourerc.com/myerc/home/dashboard/>.

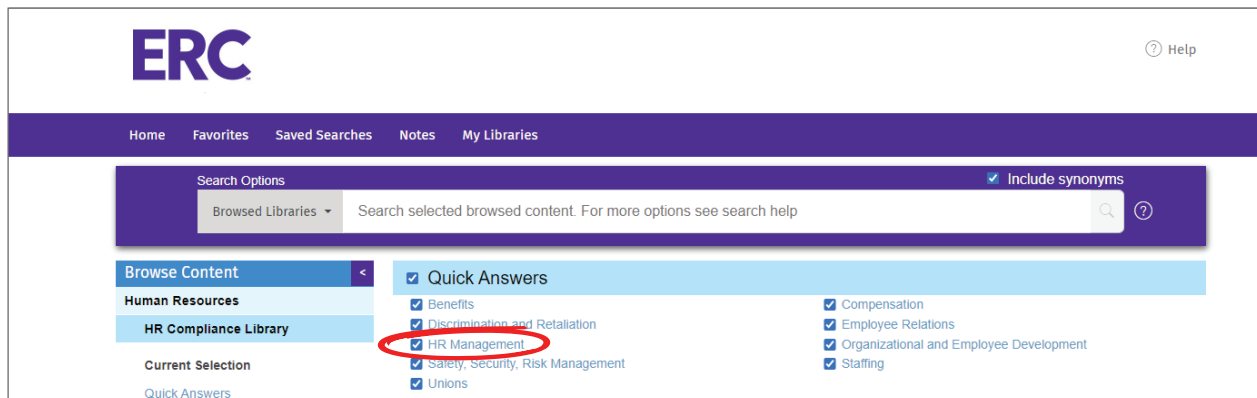
STEP 1: Select **AnswersNow** from the left menu (AnswersNow is a Wolters Kluwer Legal and Business resource)
